



### **Purpose**

The Professional Advisory Council (PAC) facilitates connections between motivated young adults and working professionals. The NET program assures all students who fulfill *Getting Beyond the System*<sup>®</sup> (GBS) seminar requirements an Informational Interview with a professional in the field of their interest. All interviews are conducted at the professional's workplace, at their convenience. Informational Interviews also may be requested by GBS graduates who are working to fine-tune or change their career goals and by youth working with NET Youth Coaches to develop a specific plan for their future.

### **General Statement of Duties**

The Professional Advisory Council secures Informational Interviews for NET program participants, promotes summer job, internship and job shadowing opportunities for qualified youth, and advances Future Link's mission in the community.

The Council is supported by the Future Link Executive Director and will receive period reports from the NET Program Director.

### **Duties**

- Schedule Informational Interviews for youth enrolled in the NET program.
- Offer suggestions to Future Link Trustees and staff.
- Represent the nonprofit to the public, including sources of financial support.
- Assist with special program projects and events.
- Participate in fundraising events.

The Council will be supported by the Future Link, Inc. Executive Director and will receive period reports from the NET Program Director.

### **Meetings**

Generally the PAC will meet twice a year to receive updates on the program.
